MARK'S MESSAGE

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO WORSHIP?

What is worship? "To pour out adoration towards another"; "A feeling of profound love and admiration". To worship God is to recognize His worth or worthiness and to acknowledge in all appropriate ways the value of what we see. The Bible often calls this activity "glorifying God" or "giving glory to God", and views it as the ultimate end, not a means to an end. The Bible also teaches that it's the whole duty of man (Ps 29:2; 96:6-9).

True Biblical worship should so satisfy us that we don't have to shop around for manmade substitutes. William Temple made this clear in his definition of worship "For worship is
the submission of all our nature to God. It is the quickening of conscience by His holiness; the
nourishment of mind with His truth; the purifying of imagination by His beauty; the opening of
the heart to His love; the surrender of will to His purpose—and all of this gathered up in adoration, the most selfless emotion of which our nature is capable and therefore the chief remedy for
that self- centeredness which is our original sin and the source of all actual sin."

I've heard so many times from Christians who neglect the assembly "But I live right". As if to say "Why do I have to come to worship if I'm living right?" As Christians we live a life of sacrifice and service. However; we must never think or even imagine that our lives lived for Him or our labor in the world is a substitute for our worship to Him and direct fellowship with Him. God is looking for "true worshipers.....for the Father is seeking such to worship Him" (Jhn 4:23-24). As important as it is to worship God in the right way, it's just as important to understand what worship is and to be an active participant. The question that we all must ask ourselves is "Have I worshiped today or did I attend worship today". There is a difference.

A CHECKLIST FOR WORSHIP

Why do we worship? Do we think about what we're doing and the seriousness and joy of it? It's easy to come to worship out of just habit and not think about what we're doing and therefore not truly worship. Here is a list that will help us keep worship in the right perspective.

- Am I coming before God to worship Him with a sincere heart? (Jn 4:24)
- Am I allowing my relationship with others serve as a stumbling block in keeping me from the proper worship of God? (Mt 5:23,24; 1 Jn 4:20)
- Am I drawing near to God in purity and holiness, or am I allowing sin to be a barrier between God and me? (1 Jn 1:6-10)
- Am I really trying to focus my full attention on God? (Ex 20:4-6; Rev 5:9-14)
- Am I fixing my vision on the Lord of glory to such an extent that my hungering desire is to draw near to Him? (Mt 5:6; Jam 4:8)
- Am I singing enthusiastically, praying fervently, giving cheerfully, and lovingly remembering Jesus during the Lord's Supper? (1 Cor 14:15, 11:23-28; 2 Cor 9:7)
- Am I coming to God in worship with a full knowledge that the only reason I have such precious access to God is because of what Jesus did for me at Calvary? (Mt 27:51; Acts 4:12)
- Am I worshiping to solely see what I can get out of it, or is my heart's desire to offer praise, thanksgiving, and glory to my Lord and King? (Rev 4:8-11)

May we always seek to worship Almighty God in spirit and in truth.
